2. Title- Vaccination for Healthy Nation

Objectives-

- 1. To spread the awareness about covid prevention
- 2. To make the vaccination facility available in the campus for students. And vaccinate.

Context-

. College was closed due to Corona. Online teaching was conducted. In our tribal area, people were scared. They were unaware of prevention to be taken and also about vaccination. People were hesitating to get vaccinated because of rumors. Hence the practice of vaccination for Healthy Nation' was undertaken by college.

Practice-

College organized vaccination campaigns in the year 2021-22 in seven phases including two doses and one booster dose in Late K.B. Dada Deshmukh Auditorium. Awareness has been created by class teachers and PHC officer (Taluka Health Officer) and his team. Students, who remained, have been called for vaccination and are vaccinated.

Evidence-

College could achieve around 97% vaccination of students successfully.

Problems-

- 1. It was difficult to create awareness about vaccination as people were scared.
- 2. Few girls fainted at the time of vaccination due to fear, or hypoglycemia, but rest of the students thought it was because of Vaccination. Hence, they were not ready vaccinate and tried to run away. Then it became quite difficult to convince them.
